IEEE ComSoc R9 is proud to annouce the 2024 edition of the IEEE Latin-American Conference on Communications (LATINCOM)! After the successful 2023 edition held in Panama City, Panama, the flagship Latin American conference of IEEE ComSoc community will be held in Medellín, Colombia, between the 6 and 8 of November, 2024.

The conference will be hosted on the University Research Headquarters (SIU by its acronym in Spanish) of Universidad de Antioquia, one of the main public universities in Colombia, located in Medellín, the second main city in the country, and the first to be designated as a Science, Technology and Innovation district.

The general Chairs of the conference, Prof. Sergio Gutiérrez and Prof. Natalia Gómez, has placed as their main goal for this edition: "to gather important members of the academic and industrial community in order to share experiences and works that are contributing to the evolution of the state-of-the-art in the communication and related topic areas".

As IEEE ComSoc R9 Board, we invite you to contribute submitting papers by July 8th, 2024, and tutorial proposals by July 15th, 2024, to strenght bonds among IEEE ComSoc R9 members and the international IEEE ComSoc community in the area to "advance communications and networking technology for the betterment of humanity."


